



GOT TALENT? Audition for the 2018 PVE TALENT SHOW!

Do you sing, dance, play an instrument, act, do gymnastics routines or have another special talent? If so, now is your time to shine!

This year's Talent Show will be held on **Thursday, April 5, 2018** at 6:30 p.m. at Northwest High School PAC to allow the students of Prairie View Elementary School to exhibit their talents. Auditions will be held in late February. Please read the rules and application carefully. Students may perform individually or as part of a group. If your child chooses to perform in a group, please make sure arrangements can be made for them to practice with the other students in their group. Any music, costumes or props needed and practice time will be the parent's/child's responsibility. Please make sure anything used in your child's act is age and school appropriate. We are looking for acts that have a positive message. Acts with inappropriate content will not be accepted.

RULES

Students must submit an online or paper Talent Show application before they will be allowed to audition.

1. Go to <http://tinyurl.com/hb497up> to register online by Feb. 16th. Additional paper applications can be picked up in the office, or printed from Mrs. Nassiff's website.
2. Each act will be reviewed (auditioned) by the Talent Show Committee.
3. **A written copy of the words to all music or skits/poems, etc. must be turned in with the application. Incomplete applications will not be accepted.**
4. If your child is using music in their act they will need to bring their CD/flash drive to the audition. No lip singing (just mouthing the words) will be allowed. **Students singing will need a Karaoke version of their song when they audition.**
5. Students need to be well prepared for their audition. Due to time constraints, a limited number of quality acts will be chosen to perform at the talent show. There is a possibility that your child's act may not be chosen. Please discuss this with your child before they audition.
6. Students will be notified as to whether their act has been approved for performance after all auditions are complete.
7. Once auditions have been held and an act approved by the Talent Show Committee, changing the act in any way or adding additional members will not be allowed.
8. All acts must be performed safely on stage and will have a **4 minute maximum time limit.**
9. All recorded music should be on a CD or flash drive, labeled with child's last name, and turned in to Mrs. Nassiff by **March 20, 2018.**
10. Any act that does not meet all the deadlines and/or criteria may be disqualified.
11. Participants may participate in **one single and one group act. Each participant in a group act must turn in an application.**

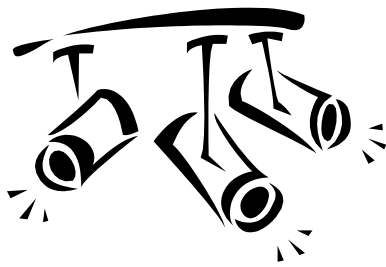

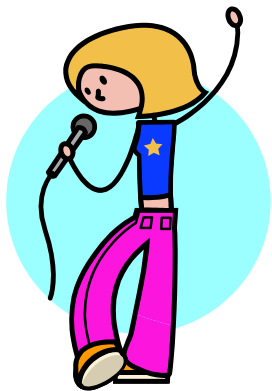
